



# **Immediate Measures for the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase**

#### **Approach re Contracting Parties**

- Communicate openly without admitting any fault or liability
- Review contracts carefully:
  - Clarify your own commitments and responsibilities
  - Consequently recognize and indicate potential breacht of contract
- Check incoming invoices carefully and, if necessary, dispute them
- Reject claims consequently
- Come up with solutions which minimize the potential damage for both you and your contracting partner in a collaborative way without recognizing any fault or liability

#### **Internal Measures**

- Promptly appoint a single contact point:
  - Centralized documentation
  - Centralized communication
- Document the orders in the context of trouble-shooting consistently
- Document the losses caused by the incident (e.g. missed orders) comprehensively

#### Approach re Insurer(-s)

- Asses insurance policy (damage cover)
- Immediately notify the insurer of all cases of loss or damage and claims made against you
